WITHHOLDING PERIODS

MEAT: DO NOT USE less than 28 days before slaughter for human consumption. Calves which have suckled on treated cows must not be slaughtered less than 4 months after the last treatment of these cows. MILK: DO NOT USE on cows which are producing or may in the future produce milk that may be used or processed for human consumption. ESI: DO NOT USE less than 42 days before slaughter for export.

STORAGE

Store below 30°C (room temperature). Store in original container tightly closed in a dry, cool place. Store out of direct sunlight.
